

# Download 1981 Camaro Z28 Owners Manual

The second-generation Chevrolet Camaro was produced by Chevrolet from 1970 through the 1981 model years. It was introduced in the spring of 1970. Build information for model 123-12487 was released to the assembly plants in February of that same year. It was longer, lower, and wider than the first generation Camaro. A convertible body-type was no longer available. Above left is a restored, high end show car steering system. To the right is a "regular" average car. On the regular car photo you can see the end of the centerlink, a portion of the steering gear (pitman arm) and a clear view of the "inner" tie-rod and the outer tie-rod, joined by the adjusting sleeve in the middle.
