The Argus company was founded in 1936, in Michigan, USA. A lot of Argus camera models were manufactured by other companies like Mamiya, Cosina, Petri, Chinon, Whitehouse, Iloca, Haking, Hanimex, Shanghai Camera and Balda. After 33 years of camera business, Argus was sold to the Sylvania company, and ceased camera production shortly after. History. Before 1939, Argus was International Research Corporation, having evolved from International Radio Corporation, an innovative maker of bakelite radio sets. President Charles Verschoor saw a business opportunity to branch out into a bakelite 35mm camera as well. The first Argus, the Argus A, resulted from a patent that the company received in 1936, and its surprisingly affordable cost ... What is it? This is a Nikon F single lens reflex camera which was made by Nippon Kogaku in Japan from 1959 through 1973. It was Nippon Kogaku's first attempt in the SLR market and was aimed at the professional photographer.
