I'd started the book quite a while back and actually had read almost half of it. Now is a good time to go back and ask students which tiles they could not use to make a fraction equivalent to $\frac{1}{2}$ (thirds and fifths). This is a GREAT discussion! Using the tiles, some students will totally get that half of 5 is $2\frac{1}{2}$, so $\frac{2}{5}$ is less than $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{5}$ is greater than $\frac{1}{2}$.
