Up for sale is a '69 Jaguar XKE. It has the 4.2 engine and a manual transmission. Overall a very good candidate for a restoration. This car has been in storage since the very early 1980s. Development. Jaguar had considered the manufacture of a DOHC V12 engine as far back as 1950, initially for racing purposes, and then developing a SOHC road going version, unlike the XK which was designed as a production engine and later pressed into service for racing.
