

Download Mac Eject Disc Command Line

Method 1 Ejecting Normally 1. Press your Mac's ? Eject button. This key is in the top-right corner of your Mac's keyboard. 2. Press ? Command and E together. This keyboard shortcut will force your CD to eject if... 3. Use the Finder. Find the disk's name under "Devices" on the left side of the ...Perhaps one of the quickest ways to eject a CD or DVD is to right-click on its desktop icon and select Eject from the pop-up menu. Some applications, such as iTunes and Disk Utility, have an eject command in a menu or toolbar. Launch the application and use the eject command to eject the CD or DVD. Use the Eject menu applet located in the Mac's menu bar. The most common way of ejecting a disc on a Mac - either a CD or a DVD - is to drag it into the trash or press the eject button commonly found in the upper right corner of the keyboard. 2 If the disc is not displayed , go to Applications / Utilities / Disk Utility, and eject from there. Right-click the disc icon in Windows Explorer (Windows 7) or File Explorer (Windows 8 or later), then choose Eject. Select the disc icon in Windows Explorer, then click Eject. As your Mac is starting up, hold down the primary mouse or trackpad button until the disc is ejected. To open or close the second optical drive of a Mac Pro computer, press Option-Eject.
