

# Download Vw Manual Transmission Fill Plug

Where are manual transmission the fill and drain plugs located on a 1998 jetta vr6, and will i need a pump to fill it? - Answered by a verified VW MechanicThe Jetta's manual transmission has two plugs for filling and emptying the transmission fluid, located on the side and bottom of the transmission case. If you are simply checking the level of oil in your transmission, start by removing the top filler plug on the side of the transmission. This is the plug that you add fluid to.Both automatic and manual transmissions equipped in the 1997 Volkswagen Jetta are sealed units. While there is a drain plug and a fill hole for the transmission, there is no dipstick within the engine bay to either check the transmission fluid levels or fill the transmission with fluid.Manual transmission fluid change how-to with pics VW MKIV-A4 TDIs (VE and PD) ...
